

Flexible Learning and Assessment



Policy statement

In line with adult orientated education, Victorian Occupational Training Educational Services (VOTES) will endeavour to the fullest extent to incorporate flexible learning, training and assessment methods and tools in the delivery of programs.

These will incorporate training and assessment that is on-the-job, in classroom based field trips, group activities, general discussion, home assigned tasks, assessment via assignment, private reading, etc.

- 3 Target groups:
- People with disabilities
 - People from non-speaking backgrounds
 - Indigenous Australians
 - Women where under-represented
 - Groups designated as significantly disadvantaged specifically targeted by funding or relative need
 - People who are denied access to education and the opportunity to gain relevant work skills
 - Refer to Access, Equity and Client Services Procedure (QP9-017)
 - Certificate I and II for people who want to get back into the workforce or to hone their basic skills in this field
 - Certificate III and IV for people who are currently employed in this field and who want to increase their skills and employment prospects
- 4 Assessment validation:
- Consultation shall be widely carried out with all stakeholders to be mindful of continuous improvements.

Assessment guidelines

- All assessments carried out for accredited courses at VOTES shall comply with the principles of validity, reliability, fairness and flexibility.
- The issuing of statements of attainment or qualifications shall comply with the requirements of the AQTF and the Standard Operating Procedure – Issuing of Certificates and Statements of Attainment (QP9-018).

- VOTES is supportive of the principles of flexibility and continuous improvement.
- Our assessments shall vary according to the specified need of the training program. Various modalities shall be used including on-the-job, classroom, and field trips.
